AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVE FOR TRAINER DECLARATION

I, licensed person, hereby declare that I take full responsibility under the Australian Rules of Harness Racing for all horses presented by licensed trainerfor theseason and undertake to represent the abovenamed trainer's interests in any matter covered by the Australian Harness Racing Rules for any racemeeting conducted within Victoria in which I am in attendance and the declared trainer is not.

In signing this declaration I understand the obligations placed upon me, and the declared trainer, under the Australian Harness Racing Rules including:

190. (1) A horse shall be presented for a race free of prohibited substances.

190. (3) If a person is left in charge of a horse and the horse is presented for a race otherwise than in accordance with sub rule (1), **the trainer of the horse and the person left in charge is each guilty of an offence.**

TRAINER AUTHORITY FOR REPRESENTATIVE DECLARATION

I, licensed trainer.....hereby give permission for licensed person.....to act as my authorised representative when I am absent for horses trained by me at racemeetings conducted within Victoria for the.....season and consent for the abovenamed person to represent my interests in any matter covered by the Australian Harness Racing Rules concerning a horse trained by me when I am not present at that racemeeting.

I further undertake that should I or the abovenamed person not be in attendance for a racemeeting then I must ensure a further representative is notified at that racemeeting and should this fail to occur I may be in breach of the Australian Harness Racing Rules and liable to penalty.

In signing this declaration I understand the obligations placed upon me, and the abovenamed authorised representative, under the Australian Harness Racing Rules including:

190. (1) A horse shall be presented for a race free of prohibited substances.

190. (2) If a horse is presented for a race otherwise than in accordance with sub rule (1) the trainer of the horse is guilty of an offence.

190. (3) If a person is left in charge of a horse and the horse is presented for a race otherwise than in accordance with sub rule (1), **the trainer of the horse and the person left in charge is each guilty of an offence.**

190. (4) An offence under sub rule (2) or sub rule (3) is committed regardless of the circumstances in which the prohibited substance came to be present in or on the

190. (6) Where a trainer intends to leave another person in charge of a horse in the trainer's absence, then prior to doing so, the trainer must notify the Chairman of Stewards, and the notification must be in the manner, within the time, and containing the information determined by the Controlling Body or the Chairman of Stewards.

190. (7) A person can only be left in charge of a horse by a trainer with the approval of the Chairman of Stewards.

190. (8) A trainer who fails to comply with sub rule (6) or sub rule (7) is guilty of an offence.
