

Participant instructions for accessing COVID-19 Vaccination Status

ORG-PU-102 (15 OCT 2021)

How to access your COVID-19 vaccination certificate and/or immunisation history statement.

Evidence of fully vaccinated status is a condition of entry into racetracks from Friday 26 November. This applies to all HRV and club employees, participants, volunteers and patrons over the age of 18 years.

There are a number of ways you can show proof of your vaccination, depending on your situation:

SERVICES VICTORIA APP

Once you are fully vaccinated, you can link your COVID-19 digital certificate to the Services Victoria app from your MyGov or Medicare app.

Once you add your COVID-19 digital certificate to the services Victoria app, you will be able to show your vaccination certificate to verify your vaccination status when you check-in using a QR code.

SMARTPHONE WALLET

Once you are fully vaccinated, you can display your **COVID-19 digital** certificate via a smartphone wallet.

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If you **do not** have a smartphone, you can provide your COVID-19 digital certificate or your immunisation history statement as **hard copy** (paper) evidence of vaccination status. You must also provide photographic identification, such as your driver's licence.

You can obtain the document by:

- Calling Services Australia on 1800 653 809 and asking them to send your Immunisation History Statement to you. It may take up to 14 days to arrive in the post.
- Printing your COVID-19 digital certificate or immunisation history statement at home, via the <u>MyGov</u> website.
- Asking your vaccination provider, medical practitioner or the Australian Immunisation Register for a printed version of your COVID-19 digital certificate or immunisation history statement.

How to access your immunisation history statement

(The immunisation history statement shows your first and second COVID-19 vaccinations as well as other recorded vaccinations that you may have had.)







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MEDICAL EXEMPTION

You must provide photographic identification, such as your driver's licence, along with:

An *Australian Immunisation Register immunisation medical exemption form* that is completed and signed by your medical practitioner and states that you are unable to receive a dose, or a further dose of a COVID-19 vaccination due to a medical contraindication or acute medical illness. Regular doctor's certificates will not be accepted.

When to use this form	Vaccines exempt due to medical contraindication
Use this form if you are a general practitioner, paediatrician, clinical immunologist, infectious disease physician or public health physician and would like to notify the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) of an individual who has a vaccine exemption due to a medical contraindication or natural immunity.	The medical basis for vaccine exemption is to be based on guidance in <i>The Australian Immunisation Handbook</i> . Advice on what constitutes a valid medical exemption to vaccination is provided on page 3 of this form.
You can record a vaccine exemption due to a medical contraindication or natural immunity online through the AIR site.
