Pony Trots Parent & Carers Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct sets expectations for how parents and carers of Pony Trots participants should behave whilst their child is taking part in the Pony Trots Program. The participation in and enjoyment of Pony Trots Victoria events, programs and activities are our primary considerations. As parents and carers your role is to support these outcomes by:

- Encouraging positive behaviour and participation in children
- Not engaging in behaviour that discriminates against any other person on the basis of gender, race, ability, colour, religion, language, politics, national or ethnic origin
- Refraining from using Social Media platforms to make offensive or abusive comments about Pony Trots, HRV, its employees, volunteers and participants or the Harness Racing Industry in general
- Not engaging in, or threatening to engage in, violent or physical confrontations with any other person
- Not encouraging or inciting junior participants to violence, or similar breaches of competition rules or spirit
 of the competition
- Encouraging junior participants and not engaging in behaviour designed to belittle, insult, mock or intimidate participants, supporters or officials
- Demonstrating good sportsmanship by respecting and acknowledging the achievements of all junior participants
- Respecting and accepting the decisions of officials and not criticising or arguing about decisions during or after the event





- Recognising the value and importance of volunteers
- · Refraining from consuming alcohol whilst spectating
- Ensuring that comfortable fitted clothing and enclosed footwear is worn (Open-toe footwear such as sandals and thongs are not permitted)
- Following any directions of Pony Trots Victoria or HRV employees, volunteers or other authorised ground staff, including any request to modify your behaviour or to leave the racecourse following a breach of these guidelines.

Serious or ongoing breaches of these guidelines are not tolerated. Those who breach our guidelines risk being asked to leave the event and/or being prohibited from attending future events. Licensed persons are subject to the Australian Harness Racing Rules and disciplinary action may be taken by the Stewards.

If you witness or have a concern regarding child safety, you must report this to the HRV Child Safe Office via childsafeoffice@hrv.org.au or speak with a Pony Trots Victoria representative or HRV Steward who can assist you with the reporting process. If you believe the child is in immediate danger please call the Police (000).
